Content of the Resource	<p>All browsers support keywords, which you can type into your address bar to quickly search or visit websites. Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, and Internet Explorer all have their own methods of setting keywords, some more hidden than others.</p> <p>Internet Explorer's keyword features are particularly hard to find, relying on a registry hack and a little-known bookmark feature. Google Chrome makes this easier, although setting a bookmark keyword requires a trick. Firefox makes this easiest of all.</p> <p>This short blog post gives step by step instructions for how you can optimise your use of keywords to perform more targeted searches, regardless of the search engine you are using.</p>
