Content of the Resource	<p>Here we list some of the best-known platforms for digital storytelling are.</p> <p>On these platforms, pupils are able to choose a setting, the characters, the style and font for the text, as well as speech bubbles, and various props, according to their storyline. Pupils are also able to upload their own images and insert them in the story as a scene or a prop.</p> <p>Digital storytelling can be used to teach the principles of narration and storytelling in general, but can also be a means for students – especially the older ones – to recreate a relevant historical event, to describe a science project, to tell about an experience done in school and so on.</p>
