<b>Topic:</b>	Copyrights and Licenses: Introduction to Creative Commons
<b>Title:</b>	Digitally Remix your Classroom with Fair Use Collage
<b>Time:</b>	Estimated time 45min
<b>Type of Resource:</b>	Class-room Activity
<b>Content of the Resource</b>	<p>A good way to express creativity and critically engaging with copyright and licenses it's through collaging using web tool <u>ThingLink</u> and <b>writing prompts and making books using <u>BookCreator</u></b> a simple to use tool to create ebook on your iPad.</p> <p>Have students cut out (copyrighted) images from magazines. Using glue and construction paper, have students mix images together into a collage. They should rework and change the images to create a new, original work that can be called fair use.</p> <p>Have students tape their collages on the classroom walls and have everyone look at the work. Students can examine how well each collage fits the key points of fair use.</p> <p>Then they can vote for the “best fair use collage” in class</p>
