Title:	Digitally Remix your Classroom with Fair Use Collage
Time:	Estimated time 45min
Type of Resource:	Class-room Activity
Content of the Resource	A good way to express creativity and critically engaging with copyright and licenses it's through collaging using web tool ThingLink and writing prompts and making books using BookCreator a simple to use tool to create ebook on your iPad. Have students cut out (copyrighted) images from magazines. Using glue and construction paper, have students mix images together into a collage. They should rework and change the images to create a new, original work that can be called fair use. Have students tape their collages on the classroom walls and have everyone look at the work. Students can examine how well each collage fits the key points of fair use. Then they can vote for the "best fair use collage" in class
