To achieve this, children need to become digital citizens. The Council of Europe Strategy for the rights of the child (2016-2021) includes a focus on children’s rights on the Internet. The guide informs Internet users about how human rights apply online and makes the protection of children one of its seven main pillars.</p> <p>The newly revised Internet Literacy Handbook is a tool for children, parents, teachers and policy makers to be able to make the most of Internet and prepare future generations to use the Internet safely and confidently by being aware of opportunities and risks.</p>
